July 25, 2022

The Jefferson County Commissioners met in regular session on July 25, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. Present were Commissioners Lynn Luck and David Christy. Linda M Buttron, County was also present. Commissioner Richard Malm and Counselor Josh Ney were absent.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Board. Payroll change forms were signed for the grant writing incentive bonus.

Public Works Director Ben Domann reported on crew work in progress.

Sheriff Jeff Herrig reported two patrol vehicles were damaged this weekend.

David moved that Resolution 2022-016 be approved regarding the award of a grant writing bonus to the Public Works Director. Lynn seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Keith Smith and David Turner, Wind N Wave Estates met with the Board. They asked questions about the special assessments for the sewer district. The Commissioners told them the best person to answer their questions would be the Health Department Administrator. The also asked about the County's assistance with snow removal for a school bus route in the subdivision. The Board stated they would look into the matter and get back to them. Also briefly discussed was the County's request for an access road to reach pump stations for the district.

The Board will travel to 118th street next Monday at 11:30 with regard to the zoning case heard last week, (PR2022-01 and Z2022-02).
