

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

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March 22, 2021

The Jefferson County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday March 22, 2021. Present were Commissioners Lynn Luck, Richard Malm, David Christy, County Clerk Linda M Buttron and Ryan Kriegshauser, Assistant County Counselor.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Assistant Counselor and the Board. David asked for discussion of the minutes. He would like to change the 3rd paragraph, to clarify that he objected to the procedure, not the motion. Lynn moved that the minutes be approved as amended. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. David moved that the minutes of March 15, 2021 be approved as amended.

Ben Domann, Public Works Director met with the Board. Ben reported he has received the title work back from the title company on the Wellman road project. The title work is now being reviewed by Attorney Adra Burks. After review certified letters will be mailed to the property owners. Ben has been in communication with Probst (the subcontractor for NexTerra, the company that built the transmission lines on the north end of the County) regarding gravel in the areas where the transmission lines were constructed. Ben calculated that \$29,000 of gravel was used above and beyond what was put done in the prior year. He has asked for reimbursement for this expense from Probst. He reported that he is working on a cost share grant due April 9th. He also stated that he has the second round of safety training scheduled for April 22nd. Evergy will be bringing their hot trailer that shows the impact of high voltage arcs. The training is at no cost to the County. He reported that Hamm's has committed to start making chips in the Perry plant which will be saving mileage traveled for loads during chip/seal season. Ben presented maps of location of graders in the County and of the grader districts in the County for the Board's information. Lynn asked for a traffic count on 21st street east of Wellman.

County Treasurer Lisa Buerman met with the Board. Lisa requested that the minimum bid be set and County owned Lots 70 & 73 Block U Lake Ridge Estates be advertised for sale. Richard moved that the lots be advertised, and the minimum bid be set at \$300.00 per lot. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

There being no further business to come before the Board they adjourned to meet in regular session on March 29, 2021.
