COMMISSIONERS**

June 14, 2021

The Jefferson County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday June 14, 2021. Present were Commissioners Lynn Luck, Richard Malm, David Christy and County Clerk Linda Buttron. Josh Ney Counselor was also present.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved by the Counselor and the Board. A purchase card request for a Sheriff's employee was signed. Lynn moved that the minutes of June 7 be approved as presented. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Treasurer Lisa Buerman asked the Board to publish Lot 733 & 752 in Lakewood Hills, Unit 4 for sale and set the minimum bid per lot. Richard moved that the lots be advertised for sale and the minimum bid be set at \$300 per lot. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Public Works Director Ben Domann spoke briefly with the Board about department issues.

Richard moved that the Board recess into executive session to discuss matters of non-elected personnel regarding an evaluation until 1:15 p.m. with Appraiser Janet Allen present to facilitate the discussion. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. The Board recessed at 1:05 p.m. Present during the session were Janet and the Board. The Board reconvened at 1:15 p.m. The chair announced that no binding action was taken during executive session.

Richard moved that the Board recess into executive to discuss matters of attorney client privilege regarding pending litigation with Ben present as part of the collective client. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. The Board recessed at 1:18 p.m. Present during the session were Ben, Josh and the Board. The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. The Chair announced that no binding action was taken during executive session.

Richard moved that Resolution 2021-014 (a resolution appointing Janet Allen to the position of County Appraiser for the period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2025) be adopted. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion.

Richard moved that Resolution 2021-15 be adopted regarding placement of regulatory traffic signs on 37th street between Circle S Lane and Union Road. David seconded. All voted in favor of the motion. The signs prohibit dumping.

There being no further business to come before the Board they adjourned to meet in regular session on June 21, 2021. That meeting will be held at the Oskaloosa City Hall meeting room to accommodate an increased number of people who may be attending next week's meeting regarding zoning cases.
